

**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF THE MAYOR

MAY 13, 2014**

BE IT REMEMBERED that the special called meeting of the Mayor and Board of Alderman of the City of Booneville, Mississippi, was held on Tuesday, May 13, 2014, at the Booneville City Hall at 6:30 p.m., the time and place noticed for said meeting. Those in attendance were Mayor Derrick Blythe and the following members of the Board: Alderman David Bolen, Alderman Harold Eaton, and Alderman Jason Michael. Also, present was Daniel K. Tucker, City Attorney and Lavaile Shields, City Clerk. The meeting was called to order in open session by Mayor Blythe and a quorum was declared present.

There first came on for consideration, Mayor Blythe requesting that the Board pass a resolution to allow the application for the Sewer Grant, which would be a one to one match. The grant could be up to \$250,000.00, and some of the match could be in kind services. Alderman Eaton made said motion, seconded by Alderman Michael, and with the Alderman present and voting "Aye," the motion unanimously carried.
