

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN
OF THE CITY OF BOONEVILLE
August 3, 2015

BE IT REMEMBERED that a special called meeting of the Mayor and Board of Alderman of the City of Booneville, Mississippi was held on Monday August 3, 2015, at the City Hall at 7:00 p.m., the time and place for said meeting.

Those in attendance were the following members of the Board: Alderman David Bolen, Alderman Harold Eaton, Alderman Jason Michael and Alderman Jeff Williams. Alderman McCoy was not present due to illness.

Also, present were Daniel K. Tucker, City Attorney, Jana Lindsey, City Clerk, and several City employees and visitors. The meeting was called to order in open session by Mayor Blythe and a quorum was declared present.

There first came before the board, Dr. Todd English Superintendent of the Booneville School System. He gave a status report of the health of the School System. No action was taken.

There next came before the Board, Leon Hayes, with the Prentiss County Development Association, giving a status report on the health of the industrial status in Booneville, and Prentiss County. No action was taken.

There next came on for discussion, the City of Booneville web cite and the need to improve said cite. No action was taken.

There next came on for discussion the possibility of the City of Booneville checking with the Mississippi Department of Transportation, about the up keep of the intersections on highway 45. No action was taken.

Next, Mayor Blythe discussed with the board the possibility of limiting the cafeteria plan to three providers. With the exception of some long term policies written by other companies to the employees. No action was taken.

Next, Mayor Blythe has informed the Board that he was looking at the possibility of other companies providing life insurance at a lower rate. No action was taken.

Next, reappointment of Department Heads were discussed, with no action taken.

There next came on for consideration the request to Adjourn. Alderman Williams made said motion, seconded by Alderman Bolen and with the aldermen present and voting Aye, the motion unanimously carried.
